Under this agreement for 2019  
Calen District State College will receive

**\$90,269\***

## This funding will be used to

- Maintain the percentage of students achieving a C or better in English > 85%.
- Increase the percentage of students that have a higher relative gain than state schooling peers in Reading and Spelling >20% in all year levels.
- Maintain the percentage of students that have lower relative gains than state schooling peers in Reading and Spelling <20% in all year levels.
- Increase the % of students who think behaviour is well managed at this school from 64.7% to 78%.
- Increase the % of parents who think behaviour is well managed at this school from 64.2% to 70%.


## Our initiatives include

- Embedding a Reading focus across the school.
- Embedding the use of the Literacy Continuum throughout the school.
- Embedding a culture of collaborative unit and assessment planning to ensure integrity of the school curriculum and alignment of the school-wide curriculum and assessment plan.
- Ensuring adequate support is provided to students 'at risk' of not achieving a C or better in English.
- Promoting Positive Behaviour for Learning (PBL) throughout the school and wider community.
